

## Simple Past – Prétérit Simple

Le principal emploi : action passée et terminée.

### *Verbes Réguliers*

Pour la forme affirmative : on ajoute -ED à la base verbale.

Exemples : I play tennis.

I play<sup>ed</sup> tennis yesterday.

Formes négative et interrogative : on utilise l'auxiliaire DID

Interrogative : Did they work yesterday?  
Yes, they worked yesterday. **Ou** Yes they did.

Negative : No, they didn't work yesterday. **Ou** No, they didn't.

### *Verbes Irréguliers*

Forme affirmative on doit les apprendre par cœur ! Voir la liste en bas pour les plus courants.

Formes négative et interrogative : on utilise l'auxiliaire DID dans le même façon que les verbes réguliers.

Interrogative : Did they eat breakfast today?  
Yes, they ate breakfast. **Ou** Yes, they did.

Negative. No, they didn't eat breakfast today. **Ou** No, they didn't.
