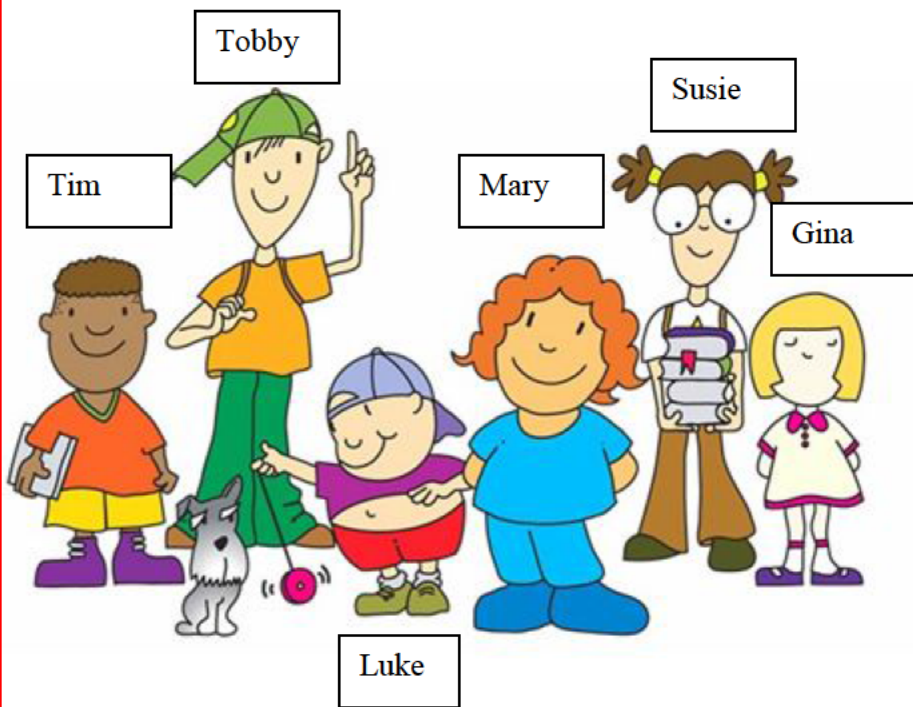


# COMPARATIVES



When we compare two things or people we add **-ER THAN** to a short adjective.

**Example:** short + **er**

Luke is short.

Luke is shorter **than** Tim.

When we compare two things or people we add **MORE + ADJ + THAN** to a long adjective.

**Example:** intelligent

Susie is intelligent.

Susie is **more** intelligent **than** Luke.

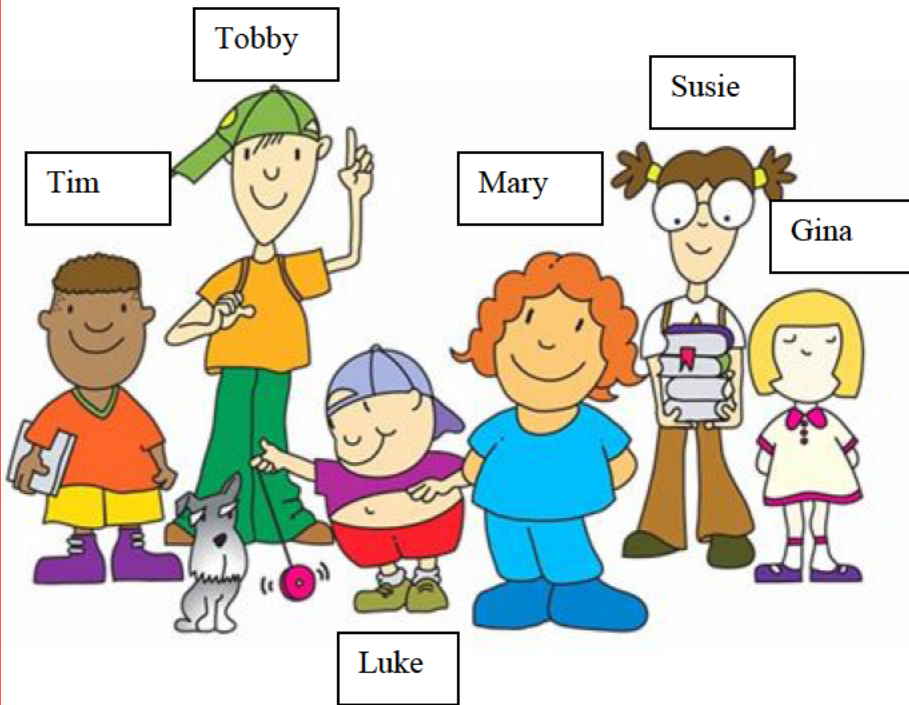
